Damon 3 are the smallest and most comfortable brackets. Half clear and half metal, they are less noticeable than regular braces. Because they are self-ligating, they reduce sensitivity, number of visits, time spent per visit, and total treatment time. These features combined with light, high-tech memory wires move teeth faster than regular braces that use elastic ties to hold the wire in place.

iBraces™

Using robotic technology, custom made brackets and wires are made to fit on the tongue (lingual) side of your teeth so they are hidden. They move your teeth more efficiently and effectively than traditional braces.
